Your findings in each case may be furnished in the following format:-

S.No.	Name of the candidate	Amount received from the party (mentioning the name of the party) as declared by the candidate in the abstract statement/expenditure account.	Amount given by the party to the candidate as declared by the party in its election expenditure statement.

In case there are discrepancies found, a copy of the abstract statement of the candidate concerned may also be sent alongwith your report.
