फोटो निर्वाचक नामावली का विशेष संक्षिप्त पुनरीक्षण 2019 किया जाकर सूची का अंतिम प्रकाशन

1. भारत निर्वाचन आयोग के द्वारा मध्यप्रदेश राज्य में फोटो निर्वाचक नामावली का विशेष संक्षिप्त पुनरीक्षण 2019 के अन्तर्गत कुल 30 लाख आवेदन प्राप्त हुए, जिनमें नाम जोड़ने के लिये फार्म 6 – 17,26,495, नाम हटाने/आपत्ति दर्ज करने के लिये फार्म 7– 7,35,258, संशोधन के लिये फार्म 8 – 4,86,415 एवं एक ही विधानसभा क्षेत्र में निवास स्थान को एक स्थान से दूसरे स्थान पर स्थानान्तरित करने हेतु फार्म 8क – 1,02,029, इस प्रकार कुल लगभग 30 लाख 50 हजार फार्म प्राप्त हुए हैं। दिनांक 26.12.2018 से 25.01.2019 के बीच दावे/आपत्ति प्राप्त कर आवेदनों का दिनांक 11.02.2019 तक निराकरण किया गया है।
2. निर्वाचक नामावली के विशेष संक्षिप्त पुनरीक्षण 2019 के दौरान 9.68 लाख कुल मतदाताओं की वृद्धि हुई जिसके परिणामस्वरूप राज्य का ईपि रेशो 62.74% एवं जेण्डर रेशो 919 हो गया है।
3. आज दिनांक 22.02.2019 को प्रकाशित अन्तिम निर्वाचक नामावली 2019 में राज्य के कुल 65,283 मतदान केन्द्रों पर कुल 5,14,02,020 मतदाता दर्ज हैं जिनमें 2,67,78,268 पुरुष मतदाता, 2,46,22,329 महिला मतदाता एवं 1,423 तृतीय लिंग के मतदाता हैं। इनमें 52 मतदाता ऐसे हैं जो विदेशों में निवासरत होकर NRI मतदाता के रूप में निर्वाचक नामावली में दर्ज हैं।
4. राज्य में सर्विस वोटर की सूची का अंतिम प्रकाशन भी आज दिनांक 22.02.2019 को किया गया जिसके तहत 65,960 सेवा मतदाता दर्ज हैं। इनमें से 27 मतदाता ऐसे हैं जो विभिन्न देशों में स्थित भारत के दूतावास/मिशन में कार्यरत हैं।

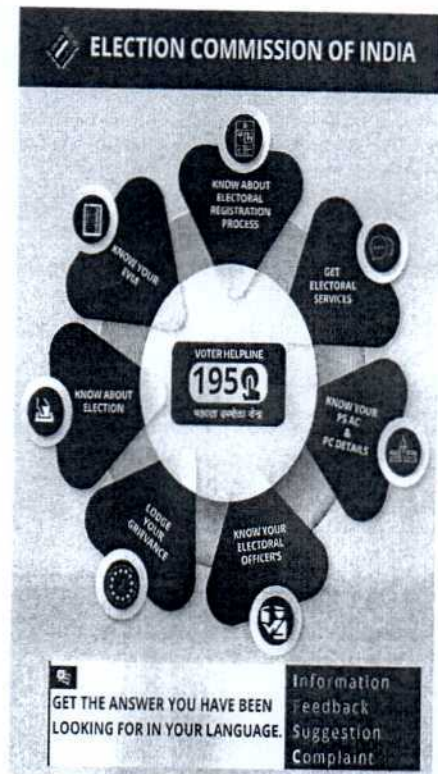

3. ECI CONTACT < Epic Number > and sent to 1950. The return SMS will provide contact numbers of BLO and ERO.
