100 Sir,

I am directed to state that the Commission is loaning ECI-EVMs for local bodies elections as and when a request is received from the concerned SEC, subject to fulfillment of conditions contained in its letter number 51/8/4/2010-EMS, dated 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2010. One of the conditions mentioned is that Commission's instructions on FLC shall be followed scrupulously. Recently, the Commission has issued a modification to its instruction on FLC, number 51/8/7/2010-EMS, dated 19<sup>th</sup> January, 2012, vide its letter dated 2<sup>nd</sup> July, 2012 a copy of which is enclosed for strict compliance.

I am further to invite your attention to the Commission's letter number 51/8/4/2011, dated 14<sup>th</sup> December, 2011 ( copy enclosed for ready reference) providing, inter-alia , that in no case , any ECI-EVM shall be moved from one place to other without its data key entered in EVM tracking software designed especially for the purpose. All SECs have been made a user of the aforesaid application and a password given. Necessary training has been imparted to all concerned including officers from CEOs /SECs offices. ECI team monitors it centrally. The Commission has, however, noted with concern that the Commission's aforesaid instruction is

not being followed in a number of transfers done in the past. Kindly take note that any loaning of ECI EVMs to SEC shall, hereafter, be subject to the condition that Commission's instructions regarding EVM tracking software are complied with in letter and spirit.

All concerned are requested to ensure compliance in letter and spirit.

Subject: - Protocol for First Level Checking (FLC) of EVMs- modifications


Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Commission's instructions number 51/8/16/4/2010/EMS dated 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2010, on the subject cited, and to state that during the recent CEOs conference held at Surajkund this issue was discussed. The Commission has now decided that the mock poll in FLC as well as at the time of candidate setting shall be reduced to 5% of total EVMs from the existing 10%. However the number of votes polled shall remain 1000 in each EVM.

I am further to state that in the mock poll which has to be conducted on the day of poll, now atleast 50 votes shall be polled, instead of 100, as of now. However, the number of votes polled shall never be less than the total number of contestants in the constituency.

The Commission's aforesaid instruction shall be read amended accordingly  
Please inform all concerned and ensure compliance

Subject: Loaning of ECI-EVMs to State Election Commissions for conducting local bodies elections- EVM tracking software- regarding.

Sir/Madam,

You are aware that a software for tracking movement of ECI (Election Commission of India)-EVMs has been prepared by Election Commission of India. The Commission provides ECI-EVMs on loan basis to State Election Commissions for conducting their local bodies elections. For the sake of comprehensive tracking of all ECI-EVM movements, it is necessary that data of ECI-EVMs in the possession of State Election Commissions, be also entered in the system. The Commission has directed that the following instructions shall be strictly followed with respect to ECI-EVMs in the possession of State Election Commission: -

1. ECI-EVMs (Ballot Units & Control Units) loaned to State Election Commission (s) which are still in the custody of State Election Commission (s),

Data of all ECI-EVMs which are in the possession of State Election Commissions should be immediately entered in the system. For this purpose the Chief Electoral Officers of the concerned State/UT shall provide technical assistance, training etc. and ensure that data of the ECI- EVMs is entered in the system latest by 20<sup>th</sup> December, 2011.

2. In case of fresh loaning of Ballot Units & Control Units of ECI-EVMs to the State Election Commission of same or other State/UT


- a) The Chief Electoral Officer of the State/UT, who is providing ECI-EVMs to State Election Commission, shall mark the requisite number of Ballot Units & Control Units to be provided on loan basis from the district (s).
- b) Then District Election Officer shall mark the requisite number of Ballot Units & Control Units to be provided on loan basis from the ware-house (s).

c) Thereafter, in-charge of ware-house (s) shall mark the requisite number of Ballot Units and Control Units to be provided to State Election Commission before handing over the Ballot Units and Control Units to the authorised person (s) of State Election Commission.

d) After receiving the requisite number of Ballot Units & Control Units by State Election Commission, the State Election Commission's officials shall mark Ballot Units & Control Units of ECI-EVMs in software for tracking movement of ECI-EVMs. For this purpose, the Chief Electoral Officer of the respective State shall provide necessary assistance/personnel and training to State Election Commission.

In no case, any ECI-EVMs should be moved from one place to another without its data key entered in the software and the EVM key marked for movement on the basis of order of the competent authority.
